Getting the right message to the right groups in a timely manner is critical in emergencies, including weather alerts such as hurricane warnings and other incidents. On a day-to-day basis, making sure the messages get to specific audiences helps recipients avoid message fatigue, which happens when too many notifications land in the wrong hands.

"We are able to target specific audiences and campuses to ensure that emergency preparedness is implemented on all levels," Landry says.

"The feature is used throughout the year during severe weather events, including hurricanes and tornado warnings, and allows us to send these warnings to specific audiences at different locations. This is vitally important because our college is spread across four counties in South Mississippi."

FUN FACT In 2006, then-President George W. Bush became the first sitting president to speak at a community college graduation ceremony, choosing to address the Mississippi Gulf Coast graduating class.
